



Access to Haddenham CHUF

Please can we remind all Haddenham CHUF parents that **access to both St Mary's School and CHUF is strictly via St Mary's graveyard and the school playground**, as outlined in our prospectus, website and recent letters. Cars should be parked outside the Church, or in the surrounding area, where safe to do so and with courtesy to residents.

Access is not allowed via the driveway at any time, as this poses a Health and Safety risk to all the children. Both staff and deliveries require access to the School and CHUF via the driveway throughout the day. Yours and children's safety is our priority and by using the driveway this cannot be guaranteed. Please note that late drop off or pick up is not an acceptable reason to be using the driveway and car park.
