Anne Barker (Manager), Sally Smith (Administrator) and the Supervisors of both sites run CHUF on a day to day basis and very little input is required from the Committee as we have ensured that systems and procedures are in place. We want to do everything we can to ensure that CHUF remains a not-for-profit organisation as it provides such a fantastic and affordable provision of pre-school education to the community. It's a great way to get involved in the community, meet new people and can provide a lot of personal satisfaction and learning.
