#### **Vale Lottery**

#### **Early Years Pupil Premium Application Process**

Since April 2015 the Government has provided the Early Years sector with extra money to help children from lower income families. This funding is called 'Early Years Pupil Premium (EYPP)', and is worth of up to £300.00 per annum for every child that is eligible. This money can be used to purchase more equipment, or to arrange exciting visitors etc to the setting. Until now we have asked parents to complete an application form when a child starts at CHUF, Bucks County Council have now advised us that in order to improve the process of applying for EYPP and to remove any barriers for parents applying to check their eligibility, that they have implemented an online checking facility.

The online checker can be used by parents, or providers and gives an instant result, generating a unique code for each individual child, and takes only a few minutes to complete.

If you apply and are found to be eligible, then please bring the code the checker will provide you with into the setting. We can then add this to our future funding claims. If you have any queries please do let us know.

# **Pick Up Times**

Please can we also remind parents of Haddenham children that access to the setting is via the Churchyard and not the school driveway which is strictly out of bounds for both your's and your child's safety which is paramount.
