


## CHUF Second Half Autumn Term 2017

### Children In Need

To mark this years Children In Need day on Friday 17th November and to raise some money for this worthy cause at Chearsley (on Thursday 16th and Friday 17th November) we will be asking the children to bring in their favourite Teddy for a small donation, look out for further details on the Chearsley whiteboard nearer the time. In Haddenham we will be holding a wear your Pyjamas to CHUF day on Friday 17th November again for a small donation, children are very welcome to come dressed in their PJ's for the day.

### Early Years Pupil Premium Application Process

Since April 2015 the Government has provided the Early Years Sector with extra money to help children from lower income families. This funding is called 'Early Years Pupil Premium (EYPP)', and is worth up to £300.00 per annum for every child that is eligible. This money can be used to purchase more equipment, or to arrange exciting visitors etc to the setting. Parents can check to see if they are eligible for EYPP by completing a simple online check. The online checker can be used by parents or providers and gives an instant result, generating a unique code for each individual child, and only takes a few minutes to complete.

If you apply and are found to be eligible, then please bring the code the checker will provide you with into the setting. We can then add this to our future funding claims. If you have any queries please do let us know.
