## **Avoiding Illness in the Settings**

Please can parents be mindful of sending their children to CHUF when they have been dosed up with liquid paracetamol (Calpol etc). As a general rule of thumb if your child needs

medicine due to being unwell then they are not well enough to be at CHUF. We are unable to administer medicine apart from when a child has a long term condition, and find that when the medicine wears off the child often feels unwell again and we have to ask for them to be collected from the setting, which can be distressing for the child. Whilst they have been in the setting they are possibly spreading their germs to other children and also to staff. Extreme circumstances in the past have led the settings to close due to staff also being taken poorly and this of course ends up affecting everyone. CHUF takes the children's well being, and the settings cleanliness and hygiene very seriously, so we are very grateful for you help with this matter. As outlined in our Sickness Policy, bouts of sickness and or diarrhea require 48 hours absence from the setting after the last bout.

## **Outdoor Clothing**

During the winter months your child needs to bring appropriate outdoor clothing to CHUF each day. We do try to spend time outside during each session, unless the weather is particularly adverse. Warm outdoor clothing should include items such as mittens, hats, scarves and wellies. Please can you make sure that all items are clearly labelled with your child's name. Many Thanks.
