### Chearsley Wednesday Afternoon's Early Pick Up's

Over the course of the Spring Term, the number of Parents and Carers collecting early on a Wednesday Pm session has increased dramatically, with pick up's occurring throughout the period between 2.30 pm and normal collection time at 3.10 pm. Whilst, early collection is completely fine, a prolonged collection period of 40 minutes has led to a lot of disruption to the normal afternoon activities and more importantly to a number of children who are not being collected until normal collection time becoming increasingly unsettled as they see many of their friends leaving but don't understand why they are not being collected too.
